DAN HELPS LIVERPOOL PLAINS SHIRE COUNCIL MONITOR DAM DEPTH!

Liverpool Plains Shire Council approached DAN as they were keen to remotely monitor the water depth in Quipolly Dam. The DAN solution included local wireless telemetry from the dam to a DAN DM01 unit which then provides data to the website via the mobile phone system. This will provide Council with a more effective monitoring solution including the provision of alarms.

DAN TECHNICAL TEAM COMES UP WITH A PERFECT SATELLITE SOLUTION!

Transmission of data through the satellite network has always been a challenge for conventional data loggers but not for DAN systems. Ian Schmahmann, head of technical at DAN explains *"the benefits of the DAN system are that it makes the connection, verifies receipt of the data and then disconnects. DAN systems therefore ensure satellite cost never gets out of control"*. Several DAN satellite systems are already on order from customers wishing to monitor conditions in very remote areas where GPRS coverage is not available.
